Lisgar School Council's primary goal is to connect with as many Lisgar parents as possible, and to offer them a conduit for speaking to the school and the board. We encourage all parents to attend our meetings and get involved. This could mean joining Council, or simply helping out with our multicultural potluck, our staff appreciation luncheon, Lisgar Lectures, Doors Open Ottawa, or issues that affect schools boardwide. We meet monthly, with a schedule that rotates through Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays (see school calendar).
